

Date: +- 1536y from the beginning or 2464y before Jesus Christ was born


Genesis 7:6 And Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth.

Genesis 22:1 And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, *here* I *am.* :2 And he said, Take now thy son, thine only *son* Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.

Hebrew 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*, **:19** Accounting that God *was* able to raise *him* up, even from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.

+-2113 years from creation (or 1887BC) JACOB was born. God later changed his name to ISRAEL – the 3rd patriarch



Mankind remains forever sinful



From the incident in Luke 16, we understand that the body dies BUT the soul is immortal. It can't die.


After the body dies, the soul can remember it's earthly life, it can see, it can hear, it can talk, it can thirst for water and it can feel pain.

Luke 16:19-31 There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day: And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores, And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried: And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented. And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence. Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house: For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them. And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent. And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

Eternal life

Luke 10:25 And, behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him, saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?

1John 5:11 And this is the record, that **God hath given** to us eternal life, and **this life is in his Son**.



How does this work?

John 3:16 says that God so loved the world that He sent His only begotten Son to come and **BUY sinners from** the **SLAVE MARKET**.

This is kind of like lobola in African culture, where the man buys the woman from her father for a certain price, and is also seen as a spiritual affair where the 2 families come together. In the Indian culture we have a similar event where a dowry is paid for the bride.

1Peter 1:18-19 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not **redeemed** with corruptible things, *as* silver and gold, from your vain conversation *received* by tradition from your fathers; But **with the precious blood of Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

...because God created mankind for Himself...
