# Who is MAN? Creation — of MAN

Gen 5:1-2 ...in the likeness of God made he him; Male and female ....

Isa 43:7 ...**for I have created him for my glory**, I have formed him; yea, I have made him.

Eph 1:12 That we should be to the praise of his glory.



1Cor 10:31 Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God

(This means that <u>our purpose in life is to glorify</u> <u>God, to enjoy God, to take delight in God and our relationship with God)</u>

### What it means to glorify God

1Chron 29:11 Thine, O LORD, *is* the <u>greatness</u>, and the <u>power</u>, and the <u>glory</u>, and <u>the victory</u>, and the <u>majesty</u>: for all *that is* in the heaven and in the earth *is thine;* thine *is* the <u>kingdom</u>, O LORD, and thou art <u>exalted as head above all.</u>

God created man for His **GLORY**: This word in Hebrew means **splendour**, or **magnificence**, **majesty**, **to praise**, **to honor**.

This means we must acknowledge God's majestic Being and worship Him for His majesty, grandeur and abundance.

We must **thank and praise** Him **for upholding** us and the earth.

We must regard God with the highest respect and admiration

### **GLORY**:

splendour, or magnificence, majesty, to praise, to honor.

acknowledge God's majestic Being and worship Him for His majesty, grandeur and abundance

Psalm 19:1 The heavens declare the **glory of God**; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.





## Who is MAN? In relationship with SIN

Rom 3:23 **For all have sinned**, and come short of the glory of God;

Rom 5:12 Wherefore, <u>as by one man (Adam)</u> sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that <u>all have</u> sinned:

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

1Co 15:56 **The sting of death is sin** ...

Jas 1:15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and **sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.** 

**Spiritual Death -** Separation or alienation of the soul from God; <u>a being under the dominion of sin, and destitute of grace or divine life</u>

#### The answer to sin

### The gospel of Jesus

#### 1Corinthians 15:1-4

- ...brethren, I declare unto you the gospel
- By which also ye are saved...
- that <u>HOW</u> Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;
- he was buried,
- and he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

Rom 3:25 (Jesus) Whom God hath set forth to be a <u>propitiation</u> through <u>faith in his blood</u>

1Jn 2:2 And he (Jesus) is the propitiation for our sins: ...

- 1. The act of appeasing wrath and stop God from being angry
- 2. In theology, <u>an atoning sacrifice offered to God to stop</u>
  <u>His wrath.</u> Christ is this *propitiation* (atoning sacrifice) for the sins of men

Heb 9:26 ...but now once in the end of the world hath he (Jesus) appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

Heb 10:18 Now where remission of these *is, there is* no more offering for sin.

1John 1:7 ...and **the blood of Jesus Christ** his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

Isa 53:12 ... because he (Jesus) hath **poured out** his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and <u>made intercession</u> for the transgressors.

Lev 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

Heb 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

Heb 9:11-12 But Christ being come an high priest ...but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

Rev 1:5 ...Unto him (Jesus) that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

1Pet 1:18-19 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

Eph 2:8 For **by grace** are ye saved **through faith**; and that not of yourselves: *it is* **the gift of God**:

In the New Testament, the object of faith is the BLOOD of Jesus Christ. (WHAT HE DID?)

Lev 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the <u>BLOOD</u> that maketh an <u>atonement for the soul</u>.

Hell is where we burn to pay for our sins but Jesus already paid for our sins

BUT I have to pick up His payment - otherwise I don't have it
