Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 11 x in **Matthew**

- In 10 text references in Matthew John the Baptist baptizes people **confessing their sins**.
- Then came Jesus from Galilee to be baptized of John
- The baptism of John represents his relation to Jesus who was baptized by him (water vs Holy Spirit)
- I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:
- <u>John's warning!</u> O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to **flee from the wrath** to come? (no repentance!)

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 12 x in **Mark**

- 11 of the text references in Mark refer to John the Baptist preaching baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.
- In 1 text Jesus says he that <u>believes</u> and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believes not shall be damned.

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 11 x in **Luke**

- 9 texts in Luke refers to John the Baptist who baptized people confessing their sins.
- 2 texts refer to Jesus's baptism by John

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 7 x in **John**

- In 1 text Jesus was baptized
- In 3 texts Jesus' disciples baptized others
- In 3 texts John baptized

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 25 x in **Acts**

- 6 verses refers historically to John's water baptism
- 1 verse refers historically to Jesus' baptism with Holy Spirit
- In 2 texts Peter addresses Jews and baptize them
- In 2 texts Peter addresses Gentiles and baptize them
- In 2 texts Paul addresses Jews and baptize them
- In 5 texts Paul addresses Gentiles and baptize them
- In 3 text Phillip addresses Jews and baptize them
- In 2 texts Phillip addresses the Ethiopian eunuch and baptize him
- 2 texts refer historically to Jesus' baptism with Holy Spirit

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 2 x in **Romans**

Both verses refer to the believer's dedication to Jesus Christ
 or being consecrated to the service of Jesus Christ

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 1 x in **Ephesians**

 This verse refers to <u>one baptism</u>, as there is only one God, one Jesus Christ, one body, one Holy Spirit

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 1 x in **Colossians**

This verse refers to baptism after the soul is saved, <u>merely as</u>
 <u>a sign</u> to others that this person now persues a new
 converted life

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 1 x in **Galatians**

 This verse refers to <u>circumcision of the heart</u> through the Holy Spirit

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 1 x in 1 Peter


 This verse refers to the <u>conscience being sanctified</u>, may freely call upon God.

Baptism, Baptize & Baptized are found 8 x in <u>1 Corinthians</u>

- In 5 of the verses Paul makes a bold statement Christ sent me <u>not to baptize</u>, but to preach the gospel
- 1 verse is a historical reference to Moses and the Jews
- All are <u>baptised by one Spirit</u>
- In 1 verse Paul gives a long debate about the resurrection from the dead

BAPTISM

Church age - period of grace



- Baptism is not found in the O.T books
- In all 4 the gospels (41 verses), John the Baptist is doing the baptizing of repentance for the remission of sins in 33 texts – Jesus is baptized in 5 of the texts and in 3 texts Jesus' disciples baptize others
- All these baptizing events are still O.T events because the Testator has not died yet, therefore the N.T has not started yet.
- The Greek word G907 explains baptism as a ceremonial ablution – to wash
- Baptism does <u>NOT</u> wash our sins away
- Baptism does <u>NOT</u> save us from the wrath of God
- Baptism is <u>a sign given to Jews</u>, because they always required signs, from the time of the exodus of Egypt

Water Baptism does NOT save the soul, is merely an outward sign and is not required by God.

Lev 17:11 ... for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

Heb 9:22 ...without shedding of blood is no remission.

Joh 4:48 Then said Jesus unto him, **Except ye see signs** and wonders, **ye will not believe**.

Eph 2:8-9 For by **grace** are ye saved through **faith**; and that not of yourselves: **it is the gift of God**: **Not of works**, lest any man should boast.
