SIN, ATTITUDE, BEHAVIOR, REBELLION according to the Noah Websters 1828 dictionary

SIN,

- A crime against society, is sin against God.
- Sin differs from crime, not in nature, but in application.
- Voluntary <u>departure from</u> a known rule or duty prescribed by God
- Sin is a <u>violation</u>, <u>or neglect to obey</u> a divine command
- Sin is deterioration of the moral character of man,
- This alienation of affections from God and his law, is called the carnal mind which is **enmity against God**.
- To <u>offend against</u> right, against men or society; <u>to trespass</u>.

ATTITUDE

• The **posture**, **gesture** or action of a person to express the action and sentiments of that person.

BEHAVIOR

- Manner of behaving
- Whether good or bad
- One's conduct; manners; carriage of one's self, with respect to property or morals
- It expresses external appearance or action; in the common duties of life

REBELLION

- An <u>open and avowed renunciation of the authority of</u> the government to which one owes allegiance
- Open <u>resistance to</u> lawful authority

Rom 8:7 Because the <u>carnal mind is ENMITY against</u>
<u>God:</u> for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

- Opposite of friendship
- Being an enemy
- · Incorrect behavior,
- Defeating the will of God,
- Causing broken relationships
- To incur guilt
- Go the wrong way

Jas 4:4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is **ENMITY with God**? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

2Cor 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath **blinded the minds** of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

Col 2:8 Beware lest any man <u>spoil you through</u> <u>philosophy and vain deceit</u>, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

It is important to kill sin or else it will kill you

Mat 7:19 Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit **is** hewn down, and cast into the fire.

- Sin is deceitful and hardens man's heart
- Then the soul becomes indifferent to sin thereby driving man deeper into sin.
- Eventually man shows no bitterness in his heart against sin which in turn has an evil influence on others and righteousness becomes obsolete.
- Thinking patterns build on previous patterns left in the brain and is extremely difficult to change

It is clear that sin comes from the mind

The man of sin wrongs and destroys his own soul

Pro 8:35-36 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD. But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death. Rom 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

In Rev 3:17 Jesus blamed the people in Laodicea for putting their trust in their riches and said they are wretched, miserable, poor, blind and naked. Similarly, modernity refocuses our interests by

- Replacing moral with therapeutic
- Replacing divine by human
- Replacing truth by intuition
- Replacing conviction by technique
 resulting in secular evangelism; called "the world".
 Worldliness displaces God and his truth and makes
 sin look normal and righteousness strange.

Life is now governed by social rules instead of morality

Php 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things

SIN destroys peace between man and God:

Gen 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife <a href="https://hittage.ncb/hitt

SIN destroys peace within ourselves:

Isa 57:21 **There is no peace**, saith my God, to the wicked.

SIN destroys peace in our relationships with others:

Gen 3:12 And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.(blame game)

Symptoms of sin are when:

- Sin settles as a <u>habitual practice</u>,
- Sin <u>frequently succeeds</u> in obtaining <u>the consent of</u> the will,
- Man fights against sin <u>only because of the</u> consequence or penalty for sin,

<u>Sin</u> builds on previous sins and <u>form habitual patterns</u>, which are extremely hard to break.

- A man's character is formed by his thinking
- A noble Godlike character does not form by chance, but by years of continued effort in right thinking.
- The adverse is also true, dishonorable, unpleasant and disgusting character also forms over years of continued groveling thoughts.
- Man does not come to the alms-house or jail by circumstances, but by the pathway of groveling thoughts and base desires and that thought turns into habit, and habit creates circumstances.

Ways in which it is possible to turn away from this un-Godly world and turn into a Godly world:

- First it is <u>a decision</u> to be taken the human thought process develops into decisions.
- Secondly it is a <u>perseverance</u> <u>pure thoughts</u> create habits of temperance and self-control.
- Thirdly it is <u>to rise above individual circumstances</u> –a man can choose his thoughts which will indirectly shape his circumstances.
- Fourth it is <u>to live a life of self-denial</u> directly against the self-seeking and self-indulgence world


Heb 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.
